One integrated view

FIXED FEES

Defined projects

Used for engagements with clear deliverables — transfer pricing documentation, valuations, structuring opinions, or defined transaction support. Fee, scope, and timeline agreed in writing before work begins.

HOURLY RATES

Advisory and opinions

Used for ongoing advisory, technical opinions, and engagements where scope is shaped by the question rather than fixed at the outset. Time is recorded transparently and reviewed against estimates.

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| 01 | Complex tax questions | Where the answer is not in the statute, the commentary, or the prior advice received. |
| 02 | High-stakes decisions | Where the cost of being wrong — financially, reputationally, or strategically — is material. |
| 03 | Conflicting external opinions | Where two or more advisors have given different positions on the same question. |
| 04 | Audit, transaction, or dispute preparation | Where a position needs to be tested, documented, and made defensible before exposure. |
| 05 | Long-term structural decisions | Where the choice today determines the tax, legal, and financial profile for years. |
